Description: The Grade 3/4's will be looking at cultural and geographical diversity. They will investigate the climate, vegetation and location of Australia, as well as community cultural diversity. The students will be visiting the Melbourne Immigration Museum where they will explore an understanding of themselves and the diverse society they live in. There will be a presentation followed by a self guided activity where students will work in small groups with teachers and accompanying adults taking a discovery trail through the museum, investigating migration stories.
